






Airbnb is an online market place that connects people with places to stay.





- Host on Airbnb part-time













- Accessibility looks different for everyone. We want to make it easier for people to find and book homes that are suitable for their unique needs.

Search Filters


- Currently, there are dedicated accessibility search filters for guests to choose from.
- Searches for accessibility features have increased by over 40% in the last year.





Accessibility Review

- Hosts are required to add photos of accessibility features, which show up on listing page.
- In 2021, Accessibility Review was introduced to help ensure accuracy of accessibility information added by hosts.





The Adapted Category

- A collection of over 1,200 unique homes around the world adapted for mobility needs.
- Each home has a 3D scan to confirm its accessibility features.
- High quality images of accessibility features and a 2D floorplan can be found on the listing

You'll set your nightly price. Then answer a few quick questions and publish your listing when you're ready.






Adding Accessibility Features to Your Listing

- If you have accessibility features in your home, in particular stepfree access, consider adding it once your listing is created.










Find a co-host to help you






Know your local shortterm rental (STR) regulations

- Check whether hosting would affect your disability benefits






